SUBJECT: Honduran Relief

President: We are pleased to get the report of your mission.

[Kleine passes around the report. The press leaves.]

<u>Kleine</u>: Honduras has only 10 percent arable land and that is the area that was destroyed. It will take two years for the banana to grow again --Honduras is a banana republic. The seas are backing up and 25 inches of rain just inundated the crop area.

President: What was the loss of life?

<u>Kleine:</u> Anywhere from 2 to 20 thousand. We'll never know. The disaster relief effort was quite good. It is the best developed country in the area.

President: What are we doing now?

<u>Kleine</u>: We are supporting them in health and sanitation. We had great help from private agencies.

<u>Murphy:</u> We have no money until the continuing resolution is passed. Burke has an Amendment for \$15 million for Bangladesh, Cyprus and Honduras. That should pass. It gives authority -- but no additional funds. Our funds for this purpose for a whole year were exhausted by 30 September. The Aid bill contains authority to use loans. That will help.

President: How much is needed?

Murphy: We can't say now. It will take a lot.

Kleine: We hope to get by until we can get some more funds.

President: We need to get others involved.

Kleine: General asked us to express his thanks.
