"WE SHOULD MAKE CLEAR WE ARE PREPARED TO DEFEND OURSELVES ALONG THE BORDER. AND MAKE SURE THE NEXT TIME IT IS NOT AMERICANS WHO GET KILLED IN A BORDER FORAY." SCOTT SAID. "PROPER SECURITY DOESN'T REQUIRE U.S. TROOPS."

SEN. WILLIAM D. HATHAWAY. D-MAINE. UPGED SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER TO WORK THROUGH THE UNITED NATIONS TO RESOLVE THE MATTER.

"THE UNITED STATES SHOULD NOT RETALIATE WITH BULLETS. BUT INSTEAD WITH URGENT PEQUESTS TO THE GOVERNMENTS OF NORTH AND SOUTH KOREA FOR NEW NEGOTIATIONS ON THEIR DIFFERENCES," SAID HATHAWAY.

SEN. JACOB K. JAVITS, R-N.Y., SAID THAT "ON SUCH A TENSE BORDER INCIDENTS ARE TO BE EXPECTED."

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
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

At about 7 am Korean time on August 20 a UN Command work group cut down the tree which the North Koreans had prevented an earlier work party from pruning on August 18.

The North Korean action, which involved the brutal murder of two American officers, was a major infringement of the rights of the UN Command to operate in the neutral Joint Security Area. It was also an attempt to threaten the future safety of an element of the UNC within the Joint Security Area.

As has been pointed out, this tree had been obstructing the view of a UNC guard post in the neutral Joint Security Area of the DMZ. Eliminating this obstruction was Wital to the safety of the guards manning this post, and therefore was a step that was essential to the ability of the UN Command to fullfill its obligations under the Armistice Agreement.

THE MORTH KOREAN ACTION, WHICH INVOLVED THE BRUTAL MURDER OF THO AMERICAN OFFICERS, WAS A MAJOR INFRINGEMENT OF THE RIGHTS OF THE UN COMMAND TO OPERATE IN THE NEUTRAL JOINT SECURITY AREA. IT WAS ALSO AN ATTEMPT TO THREATEN THE FUTURE SAPETY OF AN ELEMENT OF THE UNC WITHIN THE JOINT SECURITY AREA.

AS HAS BEEN POINTED OUT, THIS TREE HAD BEEN OBSTRUCTING THE VIEW OF A UNC GUARD POST IN THE NEUTRAL JOINT SECURITY AREA OF THE DMZ. - 2. I WAS GREATLY SHOCKED AT THE SAD NEWS OF BRUTAL MURDER OF SOME MILITARY PERSONNEL OF THE UNITED NATIONS COMMAND WHO ENGAGED IN A PEACEFUL WORK AT THE JOINT SECURITY AREA, PANMUNJOM, AND CANNOT HELP BUT EXPRESS OUR OWN INDIGNATION AGAINST THE INHUMAN ACT OF THE COMMUNIST SOLDIERS AND THEIR SERIOUS VIOLATION OF THE ARMISTICE AGREEMENT.
- 3. 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IMPRESS THE WORLD ON THEIR NAKED AGGRESSIVENESS AGAINST PEACE-LOVING COUNTRIES SUCH AS THE UNITED STATES AND THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA. FURTHERMORE, THEIR DESPERATE ACTS TO MEIGHTEN TENSIONS ON THE KOREAN PENINSULA CALL FOR CONTINUED VIGILANCE ON OUR PART AGAINST THE SINISTER MANEUVERS OF NORTH KOREA IN THE FUTURE.

C. AIR: (S/NFD) NORTH KOREAN AIR FORCE (NKAF) FLIGHT ACTIVITY WAS LOW WITH THE ONLY FLYING REFLECTED BEING CIVIL AIR BUREAU LI-2'S CONDUCTING DOMESTIC FLIGHTS, VERY POOR FLYING HEATHER IN NORTH KOREA DURING ENTIRE PERIOD. 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
