1. THANK YOU FOR YOUR FURTHER RATIONALE ON PRECONSULTATIONS. I REMAIN DUBIOUS. FOR EXAMPLE, IT SEEMS TO ME THAT THERE IS LITTLE TO BE GAINED BY TELLING THE REPRESENTATIVES TO THE WORLD FOOD CONFERENCE ABOUT MY PROPOSALS ON THE EVE OF THEIR DEPARTURE SINCE IT WILL THEN BE TOO LATE FOR THEM TO GET NEW INSTRUCTIONS ANYWAY. IF WE TELL THEM EARLIER, THEN WE RISK LEAKS.

2. NEVERTHELESS, I AGREE ON BALANCE THAT WE SHOULD ALERT THE EXPORTERU TO OUR SUGGESTIONS ABOUT THE EXPORTERS GROUP. YOU ARE AUTHORIZED TO DO SO BY CALLING IN THEIR AMBASSADORS ON MONDAY MORNING NOVEMBER 4 AND TALKING TO THEM ALONG THE LINES YOU SUGGEST. THEY SHOULD BE STRICTLY ADMONISHED ABOUT THE NEED FOR CONFIDENTIALITY UNTIL MY SPEECH.

3. AS FOR THE RESERVES GROUP THERE HAS BEEN SUFFICIENT FORESHADOWING THAT NO ONE WILL BE SURPRISED. THERE IS VIRTUALLY NO CHANCE THAT EITHER THE PRC OR THE USSR WILL JOIN OUR EFFORT. 



AND CPB IN POSITIONS OF POWER ON THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE AND THE DESIRE TO HEAD OFF WHAT PLOTTERS EXPECT WOULD BE THE CONSEQUENT POLITICIZATION OF THE MILITARY. WE HAVE RESERVATIONS, HOWEVER, REGARDING LIKELIHOOD OF A COUP ATTEMPT AT THIS TIME, BASED SOTH ON THE LIMITED SOURCE OF THE REPORTS AND THE FOLLOWING CONSIDERATIONS:

A. WHILE MUJIB HAS DONE NOTHING TO IMPROVE THE SITUATION IN BANGLADESH SINCE ESTABLISHING ONE-PARTY STATE, NEITHER HAS HE DUNE ANYTHING YET DRASTICALLY REPRESSIVE OR FURTHER DAMAGING TO THE ECONOMY THAT WOULD SET STAGE FOR A COUP EFFORT. ALTHOUGH MOVING INTO ANOTHER SHASONAL PERIOD OF FOUD SHORTAGES AND PRICE AND DISTRIBUTION OF PROBLEMS, BANGLADESH IS NOT SO FAR IN THE PUSITION OF LAST FALL THAT GREATED CRISIS ATMOSPHERE AND ANGER

8. MUJIB'S PACE HAS SEEN DESIGNED TO BUY TIME AND KEEP COUNTRY GUESSING, SO FAR, BENGALEES HAVE LARGELY ACQUIESCED IN CHANGE IN SYSTEM WHILE AWAITING EVIDENCE OF PRESIDENT'S REAL INTENTIONS. PRESENTLY HE IS CONCENTRATING ON BUILDING APPEARANCE OF NATIONAL UNITY THROUGH ATTEMPTING TO BROADEN BASE OF HIS BAKSAL PARTY TO INCLUDE UTHER POLITICAL AND SPECIAL INTEREST GROUPS IN COUNTRY, POSSIBLY INCLUDING REPRESENTATIVES OF THE MILITARY.

C. ALTHOUGH MUJIR'S REPUTATION HAS GREATLY ERODED IN PAST THREE YEARS, HE IS STILL ONLY REAL MATIONAL POLITICAL FIGURE, PARTICULARLY IN HIS ROLE OF "FATHER OF THE MATION." 6. MUJIB AND COOPERATION. THREE MONTHS AGO, THERE WAS THE POSSIBILITY THAT MUJIE WOULD COOPERATE WITH, IF NOT COMOPT. COUP PLOTTERS IN ESTABLISHING A MARTIAL LAN ADMINISTRATION. THEN HE COULD HAVE JUSTIFIED IT AS THE CONSEQUENCE OF A CORRUPT AND UNCONTROLLABLE AWAMI LEAGUE AND BUREAULRACY THAT HAD FAILED HIM. NOW HE HAS DEPRIVED HIMSELF OF THAT OPTION, DALY THREE MONTHS AFTER HIS TAKING ALL POWERS INTO HIS OWN HANDS HE HAS MADE CLEAR THAT ANY COUP ATTEMPT WOULD UNMISTAKABLE BE DIRECTED AGAINST HIM PERSUNALLY. HE IS MORE LIKELY TO QUIETLY JAIL THE PLOTTERS AND MOVE TO VET THE ARMY POLITICALLY AND ESTBLISH GREATER CONTROL OVER IT.

A. ASSUMPTION: NO COUP ATTEMPT, OH FLOT DISCOVERED, NO PUBLICITY, NO SIGNIFICANT POLICY SIMPLICATIONS.

B. ASSUMPTION: UNSUCCESSFUL COUP ATTEMPT. AS MENTIONED IN PARA SEVEN, MUJIB AND HIS ADVISORS WILL LIKELY LABLE THE ATTEMPT THE HURK OF AGENTS OF FUREIGN IMPERIALISM OUT TO DESTROY BANGLADESH, MUJIH MOULD PROHABLY GIVE FAIRLY FREE REIGN TO HIS BANSAL WURKERS TOWATTACK" THE "IMPERIALIST" CONSPIRACY, VERY LIKELY SPECIFICALLY BLAMING THE PAKISTANIS. WHETHER MUJIH PERMITS ATTACKS UPON THE UNITED STATES HOULD DEPEND UPON THE ASCENDANCY. OF HIS LEFTIST ADVISORS IN THE AFTERMATH AND THE EXTENT OF HIS EMOTIONAL RESPONSE. WE DOUBT THAT MUJI'S ON REFLECTION MOULD WENT TO JEOPARDIZE THE ASSISTANCE PRUGRAM BY THYING TO FABRICATE ANY DIRECT US-PAKISTANI LINK TO A COUP ATTEMPT. 1. PRESIDENT MOSHTAQUE AMMED TELEPHONED ME AT 0810 AND WE HAD THE FOLLOWING BRIEF CONVERSATION. THE PRESIDENT SAID THAT, AS I KNEW, THERE WAS SOME TROUBLE. MOSHARRAF HAD DONE IT, HE SAID. I ASKED IF MOSHARRAF HAD SUCCEEDED AND THE PRESIDENT REPLIED THAT MOSHARRAF WANTED TO BE CHIEF OF STAFF AND THERE WERE TWO OR THREE OTHER POINTS. THE PRESIDENT HAD SAID THERE WAS NO HARM IN THIS - LET HIM COME AND TALK TO ME (THE PRESIDENT). THE PRESIDENT WENT ON TO SAY THAT MOSHARRAF HAS NOT DONE THAT BUT WAS MAKING A SHOW OF STRENGTH WITH THE MIGS. WHEN I ASKED IF MOSHARRAF HAD ALL THE MIGS UNDER HIS CONTROL, THE PRESIDENT REPLIED THAT HE HAD ONE MIG WHICH WE HAD UNDOUBTEDLY HEARD FLYING OVER THE CITY, HE SAID THAT THE RUSSIANS WERE HELPING MOSHARRAF AND THAT THE INDIANS MIGHT BE HELPING AS WELL, HE SAID THAT HE DID NOT KNOW WHAT THE RIGHT LANGUAGE WAS OR WHAT TO REQUEST OF US, BUT HE WANTED NO BLOODSHED, HE SAID THERE HAD BEEN NO FIRING AS YET. I REPLIED THAT I WAS EVEN AT THE MOMENT MEETING WITH MY SENIOR STAFF TO TRY TO UNDERSTAND THE SITUATION AND WE WERE OF COURSE IN TOUCH WITH WASHINGTON. I CLOSED THE CONVERSATION BY WISHING THE PRESIDENT GOOD LUCK.

2. WHILE HIS MANNER WAS LOW-KEY, THE PRESIDENT'S HIGHLY AGITATED STATE WAS BETRAYED BY A STUTTERING WHICH IS NOT NOTICEABLE DURING HIS NORMAL CONVERSATION.

3. COMMENT: ALTHOUGH THE PRESIDENT HAS IDENTIFIED THE SOVIETS AS ALLIED WITH MOSHARRAF, AND HAS EXPRESSED HIS SUSPICION OF INDIAN INVOLVEMENT, WE AS YET HAVE NO OTHER INFORMATION TO SUPPORT THIS, ALTHOUGH SUCH POSSIBILITIES CLEARLY CANNOT BE DISMISSED. THE DEPARTMENT MAY WISH TO CONSIDER BEING IN TOUCH WITH THE SOVIET AND INDIAN GOVERNMENTS ATNLEAST TO SHARE OUR CONCERN ABOUT THE SITUATION HERE AND TO INDICATE THE DESIRABILITY FOR RESTRAINT ON ALL SIDES.

IN I WAS FINALLY ABLE TO REACH PRINCIPAL SECRETARY TO THE PRESIDENT, MAHBULE ALAM CHASHI, AT 11:30 TODAY TO INFORM HIM THAT USG WAS CONSIDERING HIS REQUEST AND TO INQUIRE WHETHER HE HAD ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE PRESENT NEGOTIATIONS. AFTER THANKING ME FOR OUR HELP IN FACILITATING THE SPECIAL FLIGHT OF MILITARY PERSONNEL TO BANGKOK, CHASHI SAID THAT THEY STILL HOPED FOR OUR POSITIVE REPLY TO THEIR REQUEST FOR THE PRESIDENT IF HE WERE TO WISH TO FOLLOW THE SAME COURSE. KHALI RAHMAN, CHIEF OF DEFENSE STAFF.

2. CHASHI REPEATED THAT IT WAS NOT NECESSARILY TO THE US THAT THE PARTY WOULD WISH TO MOVE AND THAT IT LOOKED MORE AND MORE LIKE THE UK. WHETHER THEY WOULD HAVE TO GO AT ALL, HE ADDED, DEPENDED ON FURTHER CONTINUING DEVELOPMENTS AND HE EXPRESSED HIS PERSONAL VIEW THAT EVENTS WERE MOVING IN A DIRECTION WHICH WOULD PROBABLY NOT REQUIRE THEM TO UTILIZE ANY OFFER OF ASSISTANCE SUCH AS THEY HAVE SOUGHT FROM US. NEVERTHELESS, THEY MIGHT

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STILL NEED IT AND WOULD BE DEEPLY APPRECIATIVE IF IT WERE POSSIBLE FOR US TO EXPEDITE OUR REPLY WHICH THEY HOPED WOULD BE FAVORABLE. THIS WOULD BE MOST HELPFUL TO THEM, HE SAID, AT THIS STAGE OF THEIR NEGOTIATIONS.

3. IN PRACTICAL TERMS, CHASHI SAID, THEY WOULD LIKE (1) THE PUSSIBILITY OF BEING BROUGHT TEMPURARILY TO DUR DIPLOMATIC ENCLAVE -- ALTHOUGH THE NEED FOR THIS MIGHT BE VERY SLIGHT SINCE THE ARRANGEMENTS FOR DEPARTURE WOULD BE PART OF A SETTLEMENT WITH THE OTHER PARTY -- AND (2) ASSISTANCE IN FLYING OUT TO A THIRD COUNTRY, I.E., A U.S. PLANE. TO MY QUESTION ABOUT ACCOMPANYING FAMILY MEMBERS, CHASHI SAID THE PRESIDENT MIGHT BE ACCOMPANIED BY ONE OR THO OF HIS PERSUNAL STAFF, GENERAL USMANY WOULD BE ALONE, AND THAT GENERAL RAHMAN WOULD BRING HIS FAMILY.


I ASKED CHASHI IF, HE CONSIDERED THAT THE PRESIDENT'S LIFE WAS IN ANY DANGER AT PRESENT (HAVING IN MIND THE PUSSIBILITY OF TEMPORARY REFUGE IN THE EMBASSY). AFTER A MOHENT OF UNCERTAINTY, CHASHI SAID IT WAS VERY DIFFICULT TO SAY BUT THAT DID NOT THINK THE DANGER WAS VERY HIGH AT THE PRESENT TIME, I SAID THAT HE MIGHT BE IN TOUCH WITH ME IF IT REACHED A POINT WHERE THE PRESIDENT'S LIFE WAS BELIEVED IN DANGER, HE SAID HE WOULD.

5. I TOLD HIM THAT I WOULD ADVISE WASHINGTON IMMEDIATELY OF OUR CONVERSATION AND THAT I WOULD APPRECIATE IT IF HE WOULD CALL ME IMMEDIATELY IF THEIR REQUEST WERE TO BE OVERTAKEN BY EVENTS HERE. HE SAID HE WOULD.

6. COMMENT. TO RESPOND TO THE POINTS RAISED IN REFTEL, I NO LONGER RELIEVE THAT AN OFFER OF ASYLUM IS ESSENTIAL TO AVERT "IDESPREAD BLOODSHED SINCE THE EVACUATION OF MILITARY PERSONNEL HAS DEFUSED THE

SITUATION, SO ACUTE YESTERDAY, TO AN IMPORTANT DEGREE. OBVIOUSLY I CANNOT GUARANTEE THAT THE PRESIDENT'S LIFE MAY NOT YET BE ENDANGERED, ALTHOUGH THIS LOOKS LESS AND LESS LIKELY. I AM NOT INCLINED, ON THE OTHER HAND, TO BELIEVE THAT OUR OFFER TO HELP WOULD BE A SERIOUS EMBARRASSMENT TO US IN BANGLADESHIS INTERNAL POLITICS AS THIS ARRANGEMENT WOULD BE APPROVED BY THE NEW AUTHORITIES.

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DEPARTMENT'S QUESTION ABOUT NUMBERS INVOLVED HAS BEEN ANSWERED BY THE PRICE EVACUATION OF THE MAIN GROUP AND CHASHI'S INDICATION THAT ONLY THREE PRINCIPALS ARE BEING CONSIDERED AT PRESENT.

7. IN SUM, I BELIEVE THAT THE DISADVANTAGES OF RESPONDING TO THIS REQUEST FOR HELP FROM A PRESIDENT

AND RECOMMEND A POSITIVE REPLY. AS A PRACTICAL MATTER, THE MOST WE WOULD PROBABLY HAVE TO PROVIDE IS AN AIRCRAFT TO FLY THE PARTY TO ITS DESTINATION AND THE CHANCES THAT WE WOULD NEED TO DO EVEN THAT ARE BEGINNING TO APPEAR SLIM. I HOPE I CAN HAVE IMMEDIATE INSTRUCTIONS.

I TELEPHONED THE PRESIDENT AT 13:36 LOCAL TIME TODAY BUT SPOKE TO CHASHI INSTEAD WHEN HE TULD ME IT HOULD BE DIFFICULT TO REACH THE PRESIDENT AT THAT TIME, DRAWING ON REFTEL, I ASKED HIM TO ASSURE PRESIDENT MUSHTAQUE THAT THE U.S. GOVERNMENT REMAINS CONCERNED ABOUT HIS PERSONAL WELFARE, THAT HE ARE GRATIFIED THAT A RESOLUTION OF THE CRISIS IN A WAY WHICH HOULD AVOID BLOODSHED APPEARED POSSIBLE, AND THAT PRESIDENT MOSHTAQUE WOULD BE WELCOKE IN THE UNITED STATES IF HE DESIRED TO GO THERE. I TOLD HIN THAT HE COULD INFORM THE PRESIDENT THAT, IN KEEPING WITH THE CONVERSATION CHASHI AND I HAD YESTERDAY, WE WOULD BE PREPARED TO PROVIDE TEMPORARY REFUGE NITHIN EMBASSY TO THE PRESUDENT OF HIS LIFE SHOULD APPEAR TO BE IN IMMINENT DANGER. I SAID FURTHER THAT IF A RESOLUTION WERE NEGOTIATED WHICH INCLUDED SUCH AN ARRANGEMENT, WE WOULD ALSO BE PREPARED TO OFFER THE ASSISTANCE OF ADMITTING THE PRESIDENT AND A SMALL NUMBER OF OTHER OFFICIALS TO OUR DIPLOMATIC ENCLAYE TEMPORARILY BEFORE THEY LEFT BANGLADESH.

2. CHASHI SAID HE WAS MUST GRATEFUL FOR THESE ASSURANCES
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AND REPEATED THAT ANY OF THESE ARRANGEMENT WOULD "ALWAYS BE PART OF A NEGOTIATED SETTLEMENT WHICH WILL KEEP YOU AWAY FROM EMBARRASSMENT, AND ALSO NATURALLY US." HE SAID THAT THEY WOULD REMAIN FOREVER GRATEFUL FOR OUR GENEROUS RESPONSE.

I ASKED CHASHI WHAT HE COULD TELL ME ABOUT THE CURRENT SITUATION AND THE OUTLOOK, HIS RESPONSE WAS CAUTIOUS AND RESTRAINED. HE SAID THAT THE SITUATION WAS BECOMING NORMAL BUT THAT A FEW MORE ITHINGS WERE YET TO BE SETTLED. HE SAID THIS STATEMENT HAD BEEN ISSUED BECAUSE THE INDIAN RADIO IN NEW DELHI AND CALCUTTA HAD QUOTED OFFICIAL SPOKESMAN ON THEIR CONCERN ABOUT THE SITUATION IN BANGLADESH.

3. I ASKED IF THE ANNOUNCEMENT IN THE PRESS TODAY THAT PRESIDENT SAYEM HAD TAKEN OVER FROM GENERAL ZIA AS CHIEF MARTIAL LAW ADMINISTRATOR HAD AFFECTED THE EQUATION OR HAD DEPARTED FROM THE SENSE OF THE STATEMENT HE HAD GIVEN ME YESTERDAY ABOUT THE PRESENT ARRANGEMENTS BEING THE RESULT OF STRONG SUPPORT FROM ALL THE PRINCIPAL PARTIES CONCERNED. CHASHI REPLIED THAT THIS CHANGE ONLY CONFIRMED THE STATEMENT HE HAD MADE TO ME YESTERDAY, THAT THIS WAS WHAT THEY HAD IN MIND ALL ALONG. HE HAVE ALSO BEEN GLAD TO SEE THAT OUR SPOKESMAN'S STATEMENT ABOUT THE FACT THAT THERE HAS BEEN NO THREAT TO FOREIGN NATIONALS HERE HAS BEEN CARRIED BY ALL-INDIA HADIO. HE HAVE ALSO SENT A REPRESENTATIVE OF GENERAL ZIAUR RAHMAN TO THE INDIAN HIGH COMMISSIGKER IMMEDIATELY AFTER ZIA HAD ANNOUNCED HIS ASSUMPTION. OF OFFICE TEMPORARILY AS CHIEF NARTIAL LAW ADMINISTRATOR TO REASSURE THEM THAT THE EVENTS WERE ENTIRELY INTERNAL AND SHOULD NOT IN ANY WAY

I INFORMED HIM THAT HE HAD SPOKEN TO THE INDIAN GOVERNMENT AT A HIGH LEVEL YESTERDAY ABOUT THE DESIRABILITY OF AVOIDING STATEMENTS WHICH HIGHT HAVE HARMFUL EFFECT IN PRESENT EMOTIONAL ATMOSPHERE AND I THOUGHT THIS POINT HAD BEEN UNDERSTOOD. CHASHI EXPRESSED APPRECIATION FOR THIS.

3. AS FOR PRESENT INTERNAL SITUATION, CHASHI SAID IT REMAINED THE SAME. THE PEOPLE IN THE ARMY WHO HAD COME OUT YESTERDAY HAD FUR THE HOST PART GONE BACK TO THEIR UNITS AND MORE HERE RETURNING. THE CUPPER

LAST NIGHT HAD BEEN USED TO CHECK THOSE MILITARY
PROPLE WHO HAD NOT RETURNED. APART FROM POLITICS, THERE WAS A LOT
OF PURELY PERSONAL NISCHIEF AND THE SETTLING OF OLD SCORES, RESULTING IN A LOT OF LOCAL LAW AND ORDER PROBLEMS. I SAID THIS WAS WHAT
HAD PROMPTED MY CALL AS I HAD BEGUN TO RECEIVE REPORTS THAT THE LOWER
PANKS HIGHT BE OUT OF CONTROL AND THAT A LARGE NUMBER OF OFFICERS
WERE BEING HELD. CHASHI INTERHUPTED TO SAY THAT WHAT I WAS DESCRIBING
HAD APPLIED TO YESTERDAY. AS OF THIS MORNING, HE SAID, THE SITUATION
WAS RETURNING TO NORMAL. THE MILITARY CHIEFS HAD BEEN GOING AROUND
FROM GHOUP TO GROUP AND

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4. CHASHI ADDED THAT THE INDIAM HIGH COMMISSIONER SAMAR SEN, WAS CALLING ON HIM THIS AFTERMOON AND HE MOULD TELL SEN THAT THEY WERE A LITTLE DISTURBED ABOUT FIRING WHICH HAD BEEN GOING ON AGAINST DAF OF THEIR BANGLADESH RIFLES GUARD POST AT HALUAGHAT IN MYMENSINGH DISTRICT FOR A FEW DAYS. THIS FIRING HAD BEEN IN-TENSIFIED IN THE LAST DAY OR TWO! THEY HOPED IT WAS A LOCAL MATTER BUT THEY WOULD BRING IT TO SEN'S NOTICE, INDICATING THAT ANY SUCH INTENSIFICATION WAS CONTRARY TO THE EFFORTS WHICH BEING MADE TO SHING ABOUT STABILITY. CHASHI ADDED THAT THERE WERE ALSO INCIDENTS OF SABOTAGE BUT THEY WERE NOT HAJON.

5. I TOLD CHASHI THAT I HOPED HE WOULD CONTINUE TO KEEP IN TOUCH WITH ME WHILE THE SITUATION REMAINED UNEASY AND HE SAID THEY WELCOME THE GPPORTUNITY TO SHARE THEIR INFORMATION WITH US AS WE ALSO SHARED THE SAME GOAL OF RESTORING STABILITY TO THE COUNTRY.

6. OFPARTHENT MAY WISH PASS TO NEW DELHI AND ISLAMABAD.

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
