1. There is pressure here for the President to put out a statement condemning the UN action characterizing Zionism as a form of racism. Whatever the ^{motivation} behind the pressure, the President is probably going to have to make some kind of statement and it is clearly preferable for him to do it before Sadat ^{rather} arrives, ^{when} than while he is here -- which is probably ~~the time~~ the General Assembly will pass the resolution. Additionally, the House and Senate are both drafting resolutions condemning ^{it} the UN action and ^{it} would be useful for the President to speak out ahead of them, ~~to avoid~~ ^{rather than} appearing to be forced by a Congressional resolution.

2. Bob Goldwin ^{shot over} ~~has furnished~~ a draft which was far too flamboyant. I have had it scrubbed and the result is the statement quoted below, drafted principally by Bill Buffum.

Proposed ~~Statement by the President:~~ "As a general principle the United States takes grave exception to any action that weakens the United Nations as an effective forum for the peaceful resolution of international disputes."

1. THERE IS PRESSURE HERE FOR THE PRESIDENT TO PUT OUT A STATEMENT CONDEMNING THE UN ACTION CHARACTERIZING ZIONISM AS A FORM OF RACISM. WHATEVER THE MOTIVATION BEHIND THE PRESSURE, THE PRESIDENT IS PROBABLY GOING TO HAVE TO MAKE SOME KIND OF STATEMENT AND IT IS CLEARLY PREFERABLE FOR HIM TO DO IT BEFORE SADAT ARRIVES RATHER THAN WHILE HE IS HERE -- WHICH IS PROBABLY WHEN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY WILL PASS THE RESOLUTION. ADDITIONALLY, THE HOUSE AND SENATE ARE BOTH DRAFTING RESOLUTIONS CONDEMNING THE UN ACTION AND IT WOULD BE USEFUL FOR THE PRESIDENT TO SPEAK OUT AHEAD OF THEM, TO AVOID APPEARING TO BE FORCED BY A CONGRESSIONAL RESOLUTION.

2. BOB GOLDWIN SENT OVER A DRAFT WHICH WAS FAR TOO FLAMBOYANT. I HAVE HAD IT SCRUBBED AND THE RESULT IS THE STATEMENT QUOTED BELOW, DRAFTED PRINCIPALLY BY BILL BUFFUM.

PROPOSED PRESIDENTIAL STATEMENT: "AS A GENERAL PRINCIPLE THE UNITED STATES TAKES GRAVE EXCEPTION TO ANY ACTION THAT WEAKENS THE UNITED NATIONS AS AN EFFECTIVE FORUM FOR THE PEACEFUL RESOLUTION OF INTERNATIONAL DISPUTES.

1. Carl Maw has sent me a revised version of the 200-mile fisheries paper which he says you have approved to go to the President. I regret to say that I do not believe the President will find it very persuasive alongside the arguments of people like Ted Stevens. It does not appear to me to be sufficiently specific in setting forth the arguments on our side ^{or} ~~and~~ in shooting down contrary assertions. It also suggests in more than one place that a Law of the Sea Treaty might take as long as three years to conclude. While it is not an action memo, it has you strongly recommending all-out opposition to the bill, including serious consideration of a veto. I can not imagine that this paper will turn the President around sufficiently to induce him even to contemplate such action. I do not mean to be critical of the paper; it is not bad, but it is not good enough. Assuming I see the President tomorrow, I will hand it to him for his leisure reading.
2. The Danish Prime Minister will be in this country next month in connection with the UN and following a trip to Latin America. He would like to pay a call on the President. Do you concur?

3. Dobrynin has not yet heard from Gromyko about the November 14 meeting date. He said that the Politburo usually meets on Thursday or Friday and he should therefore have an answer in the next day or so. He also made clear that it was Schlesinger who suggested that Dobrynin pay a call on him at Defense, ~~and not Dobrynin's idea.~~

4. I have just heard that Pike intends to have hearings beginning October 29 on "the NSC system." The first two witnesses will be Bill Watts and Tony Lake. How does that grab you?

5. The Vice President now plans to join Sadat in Chicago, fly with him to Texas, ^{on Friday} and participate in the dinner that evening. He intends to depart immediately following the dinner, however, and will therefore not accompany Sadat on his ^{Saturday} visit to a ranch (reportedly owned by a Connally friend) or to the Houston Space Center.

6. As far as I can see, we are in a condition of almost total chaos with respect to our thinking about the future organization and functioning of the intelligence community. We are focussed almost exclusively on the suggestions of the Murphy and Rockefeller Commissions. It seems to me that there may be some merit in directing an NSC study on the organization of the intelligence community. It may be a little late, but I fear it ^{may be} ~~is~~ the only way to have a really thoughtful look at the problem.

1. CARL HAN HAS SENT ME A REVISED VERSION OF THE 200-MILE FISHERIES PAPER WHICH HE SAYS YOU HAVE APPROVED TO GO TO THE PRESIDENT. I REGRET TO SAY THAT I DO NOT BELIEVE THE PRESIDENT WILL FIND IT VERY PERSUASIVE ALONGSIDE THE ARGUMENTS OF PEOPLE LIKE TED STEVENS. IT DOES NOT APPEAR TO ME TO BE SUFFICIENTLY SPECIFIC IN SETTING FORTH THE ARGUMENTS ON OUR SIDE OR IN SHOOTING DOWN CONTRARY ASSERTIONS. IT ALSO SUGGESTS IN MORE THAN ONE PLACE THAT A LAW OF THE SEA TREATY MIGHT TAKE AS LONG AS THREE YEARS TO CONCLUDE. WHILE IT IS NOT AN ACTION MEMO, IT HAS YOU STRONGLY RECOMMENDING ALL-OUT OPPOSITION TO THE BILL, INCLUDING SERIOUS CONSIDERATION OF A VETO. I CAN NOT IMAGINE THAT THIS PAPER WILL TURN THE PRESIDENT AROUND SUFFICIENTLY TO INDUCE HIM EVEN TO CONTEMPLATE SUCH ACTION. I DO NOT MEAN TO BE CRITICAL OF THE PAPER; IT IS NOT BAD, BUT IT IS NOT GOOD ENOUGH. ASSUMING I SEE THE PRESIDENT TOMORROW, I WILL HAND IT TO HIM FOR HIS LEISURE READING.

2. THE DANISH PRIME MINISTER WILL BE IN THIS COUNTRY NEXT MONTH IN CONNECTION WITH THE UN AND FOLLOWING A TRIP TO LATIN AMERICA. HE WOULD LIKE TO PAY A CALL ON THE PRESIDENT.

3. DOBRYNIN HAS NOT YET HEARD FROM GROMYKO ABOUT THE NOVEMBER 14 MEETING DATE. HE SAID THAT THE POLITBURO USUALLY MEETS ON THURSDAY OR FRIDAY AND HE SHOULD THEREFORE HAVE AN ANSWER IN THE NEXT DAY OR SO. HE ALSO MADE CLEAR THAT IT WAS SCHLESINGER WHO SUGGESTED THAT DOBRYNIN PAY A CALL ON HIM AT DEFENSE.

4. I HAVE JUST HEARD THAT PIKE INTENDS TO HAVE HEARINGS BEGINNING OCTOBER 29 ON "THE NSC SYSTEM." THE FIRST TWO WITNESSES WILL BE BILL WATTS AND TONY LAKE. HOW DOES THAT GRAB YOU?

5. THE VICE PRESIDENT NOW PLANS TO JOIN SADAT IN CHICAGO, FLY WITH HIM TO TEXAS ON FRIDAY AND PARTICIPATE IN THE DINNER THAT EVENING. HE INTENDS TO DEPART IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE DINNER, HOWEVER, AND WILL THEREFORE NOT ACCOMPANY SADAT ON HIS SATURDAY VISIT TO A RANCH (REPORTEDLY OWNED BY A CONNALLY FRIEND) OR TO THE HOUSTON SPACE CENTER.

6. AS FAR AS I CAN SEE, WE ARE IN A CONDITION OF ALMOST TOTAL CHAOS WITH RESPECT TO OUR THINKING ABOUT THE FUTURE ORGANIZATION AND FUNCTIONING OF THE INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY. WE ARE FOCUSSED ALMOST EXCLUSIVELY ON THE SUGGESTIONS OF THE MURPHY AND ROCKEFELLER COMMISSIONS. IT SEEMS TO ME THAT THERE MAY BE SOME MERIT IN DIRECTING AN NSC STUDY ON THE ORGANIZATION OF THE INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY. IT MAY BE A LITTLE LATE, BUT I FEAR IT MAY BE THE ONLY WAY TO HAVE A REALLY THOUGHTFUL LOOK AT THE PROBLEM.

ILO CHIEF BRIEFS EC ON U.S. POSITION TOWARD ILO: ILO
 DIRECTOR GENERAL BLANCHARD, WHO IS CURRENTLY IN THE U.S.
 FOR TALKS WITH GOVERNMENT AND LABOR UNION LEADERS, HAS
 BRIEFED THE EC NINE AMBASSADORS ON THE U.S. DECISION TO
 GIVE THE MANDATORY TWO-YEAR ADVANCE NOTICE OF INTENT TO
 WITHDRAW FROM THE ILO. AN ACCOUNT OF THE BRIEFING HAS
 BEEN PROVIDED TO THE U.S. MISSION IN GENEVA BY AN ITALIAN
 OFFICIAL. BLANCHARD STRONGLY URGED THE EC MEMBERS TO
 MAKE INDIVIDUAL DEMARCHES IN WASHINGTON AIMED AT PERSUADE-
 NG THE U.S. TO RECONSIDER WITHDRAWAL. HE APPEARED TO RECO-
 GNIZE THAT AN ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE NOTIFICATION OF INTENT
 PROBABLY COULD NOT BE AVERTED. HE THINKS THAT THE U.S.
 ACTION IS A "TACTIC" TO ACHIEVE IMPROVEMENTS IN ILO STRUC-

PLO MAY ACT TO POSTPONE DEBATE IN UN: THE PLO REPORTEDLY WANTS THE UNGA TO PUT OFF DEBATE ON THE PALESTINE QUESTION UNTIL AFTER EGYPTIAN PRESIDENT SADAT ADDRESSES THE ASSEMBLY NEXT WEDNESDAY. THE POSTPONEMENT WOULD GIVE THE ARAB STATES TIME TO WORK OUT A COMMON POSITION FOR THE DEBATE. AFRICAN CRUDE OIL LEADS WAY AS OPEC STATES RAISE PRICES: MEMBERS OF OPEC ARE SETTING NEW HIGHER PRICES. 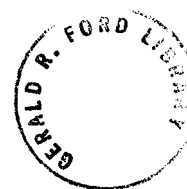

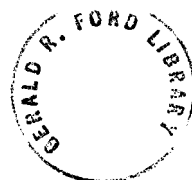

LYNN HAS SIGNED OMB SUBMISSION TO THE PRESIDENT ON FY 176 SECURITY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM. WE ARE PREPARING A COVERING MEMORANDUM WHICH WILL LAY OUT THE ISSUES MORE CLEARLY ON A COUNTRY-BY-COUNTRY BASIS, STATING OUR POSITION AND RECOMMENDING, INTER ALIA, THAT THE PRESIDENT STICK BY DECISIONS ON BUDGET LEVELS WHICH HE HAS ALREADY MADE, AND ACCEPT THE JUDGMENTS OF STATE AND NSC ON THE MIDDLE EAST AND GREECE/TURKEY PACKAGES. WE WILL NEED A DECISION FROM THE PRESIDENT BY MONDAY NOON IN ORDER TO GET THE FIGURES IN THE HOUSE BILL BEFORE IT GOES TO THE FLOOR.

TURKISH AMBASSADOR TO FRANCE KILLED: THE TURKISH AMBASSADOR TO FRANCE ISMAIL EREZ AND THE CHAUFFEUR OF HIS CAR WERE KILLED TODAY BY GUNMEN ON A PARIS STREET NEAR THE TURKISH EMBASSY. PARIS POLICE QUOTED WITNESSES AS SAYING THAT THE GUNMEN OPENED FIRE ON THE CAR AS IT NEARED THE BIR HAKEIM BRIDGE OVER THE SEINE. THE GUNMEN ESCAPED ON FOOT. THE NATIONAL FRONT FOR THE LIBERATION OF ARMENIA IS CLAIMING RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE DEATH.

J.S. EQUIPMENT TO BE SHIPPED FROM VIETNAM: THE VIETNAMESE ARE ROUNDING UP SEVERAL TYPES OF SOPHISTICATED COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT FOR DELIVERY TO THE SOVIETS AND CHINESE. INCLUDED AMID THE GEAR ARE AIRCRAFT RADIOS AND COMPONENT PARTS OF COMPLETE RADIO SYSTEMS. INTERCEPTS CALL FOR THE MATERIAL TO BE ASSEMBLED IN DANANG BY OCTOBER 29 FOR THE RUSSIANS AND BY NOVEMBER 10 FOR THE CHINESE. THIS IS THE FIRST SOLID EVIDENCE OF THE SHIPMENT OF CAPTURED U.S. EQUIPMENT BY THE VIETNAMESE OUTSIDE OF THE COUNTRY.

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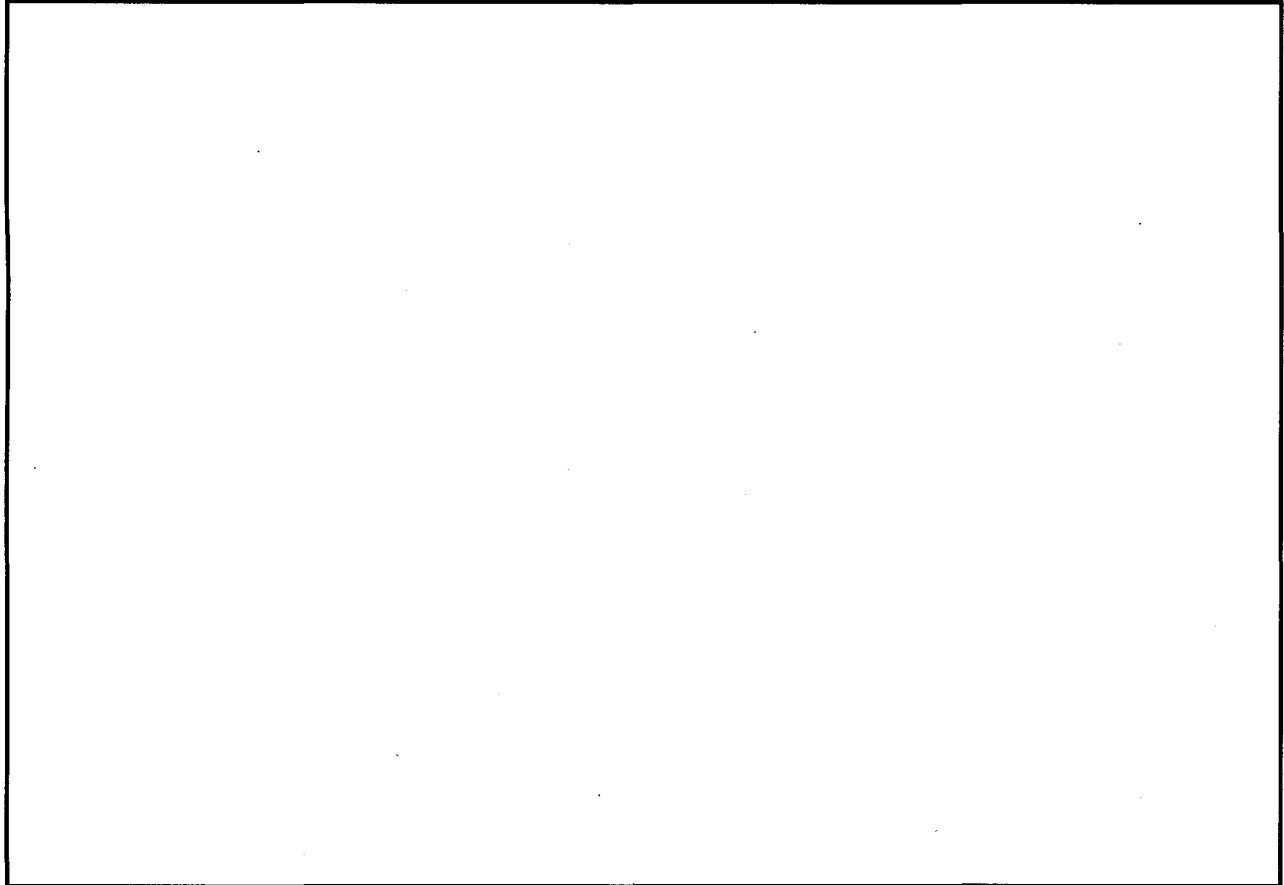
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
