Armed Clash Between Cambodians and Thais: An armed clash between Cambodians and Thais has occurred in northwestern Cambodia, according to a November 11 report. The skirmish resulted in one Cambodian killed and four wounded, while "enemy" losses were reported as four killed. The Thais may have been conducting reconnaissance operations at the time of the incident. Earlier reports of November 7 and 8 had discussed Thai sweep operations against "In Tam guerrillas" inside the Cambodian border and instructions to local Cambodian officials to insure that the Thai forces operated only on the Thai side of the border. reported clash may have resulted from Cambodian attempts to force the Thais back across the border.
