> Information requested by J. Lee Bankin, General Counsel, President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy, relative to bus travel between Dallas and Mexico City, D. F., attached herewith.

## DETAILS OF INVESTIGATION

This case originated with a letter dated April 3, 1964, to Chief, U. S. Secret Service, from Mr. J. Lee Rankin, General Counsel, President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy. Mr. Bankin asked for information relative to bus travel between Dallas, Texas, and Moxico City, D. F., on November 22, 1963. This letter was transmitted to this office with Chief's O/M dated April 7, 1964, and received in this office on April 13, 1964, which O/M requested the information be gathered and forwarded to Chief's Office at earliest practicable date.

## Other Investigations

On April 14, 1964, interviewed Mr. McFadden, Terminal Manager, Greyhound Bus Depot, Dallas, Texas. Mr. McFadden furnished the information requested in the letter by Mr. J. Lee Bankin, General Counsel. (MOTE: Below are two mileage tables - (1) Dallas to Texas points of entry into Mexico; (2) Dallas to Mexico City via different routes to Mexico City.)

## (1) Dallas, Texas to Texas points of entry into Muxico:

Dallas to Laredo - 427 miles
Dallas to Eagle Pass - 409 miles

## (2) Dallas, Texas to Mexico City via different routes:

Dallas, Texas to Mexico City via Laredo - 1174 miles
Dallas, Texas to Mexico City via Brownsville - 1162 miles
Dallas, Texas to Mexico City via Eagle Poss - 1241 miles
Dallas, Texas to Mexico City via Dal Rio - 1290 miles
(speroximately)

The information requested by Mr. J. Lee Bankin has been ascertained as follows:

(1) How would a person go from Dallas
(a) by bus to the closest points on the Maxican border, and to Maxico City?

The Greybound Bus Lines has a regular run to Laredo, Texas, which is the border crossing point most used by traffic from the Dallas area. The schedule of this run is attached (Schedule Bo. 1). This trip from Laredo would proceed from Dallas through Waco, Austin, San Antonio, and then directly to Laredo.

The Continental Bus Lines also has a scheduled trip to Laredo, however, this bus does not go to San Antonio and Laredo by a direct route.

The bus routes are marked on Map 1(a) - Greyhound Bus Lines in blue; and Trailways Bus Lines in red.

The main crossing points on the Mexican border are at Del Rio, Eagle Pass, Leredo, and Brownsville, Texas. The Greyhound Bus runs directly to Leredo, however, it does not run to Del Rio, Brownsville, or Eagle Pass.

To obtain these other stations, one must change buses at San Antonio for Del Rio; at San Antonio for Brownsville; and connect with Winter-garden Bus Lines at Dilley, Texas. The schedules for buses connecting Del Rio, Brownsville, and Eagle Pass, specifically the Trailways Bus Lines, the Painter Bus Lines, and the Winterparden Bus Lines are attached.

These bus routes are also marked on Map 1(a) - the Painter Bus Lines in green; and the Wintergarden Bus Lines in yellow.

There were no American bus lines operating in the country of Mexico on Movember 22, 1963. Once at the border, the traveler would be forced to change to one of three bus lines, depending upon his location at the border. If the individual was at Laredo, he would most probably take the Transportes Del Horte Bus Lines, which route is marked in brown on Map 1(c). This Bus Line connects with Greyhound at the Greyhound Terminal, Laredo, Texas. If arriving at Brownsville, he would probably take the Autobuses Blancos Flechs Roja, which is marked in blue on Map 1(c). If the individual arrived at Del Rio or Eagle Pass, he would probably take the Autobuses Anahume, which is marked in red on Map 1(c).

The best route by bus to Mexico City would, therefore, be by Greyhound Bus from Dallas to Laredo, and then continue by the Transportes Del Morte Bus Lines to Mexico City.

(1) How would a person go from Dallas
(b) by hitchhiking to the closest points on the Mexican border, and to
Mexico City?

An individual hitchhiking to the Mexican border and to Mexico City would most probably travel by the Dallas-Maco-Austin-San Antonio-Laredo route. This route would certainly be the most heavily travelled route to the Mexican border. This route is sketched on Map 1(b) which is attached. There are also two alternate routes - first alternate sketched in yellow on Map 1(b) and second alternate sketched in green on Map 1(b).

The route a person will probably travel while hitchhiking from the border to Mexico City is marked in red on Map 1(d). The Mexican Tourist Bureau, Dallas, Texas, advises this is the most heavily travelled route to Mexico City, and therefore, this route should afford more chances of getting a ride. First alternate route from the border near Brownsville, Texas, and McAllen, Texas, to Mexico City is marked in blue; second alternate route from Del Rio and Eagle Pass is marked in a combination blue and red line - all on Map 1(d).

(2) What was the bus fare on November 22, 1963, from Dallas to the closest points on the Mexican border, and to Mexico City?

Below are bus fares from Dallas to points on the Mexican border; fares from these points to Mexico City; and total fares from Dallas to Mexico City:

All of the above are one-way fares for November 22, 1963. Tickets on the Mexican lines can be purchased in U. S. Bus Terminals. The fares quoted in column 2 above are those of the Transportes Del Norte Bus Lines.

(3) What were the bus schedules on November 22, 1963, from Dallas to the closest points on the Mexican border, and to Mexico City?

Bus schedules of the Greyhound Bus Lines, Continental Trailways Bus Lines, Winter Garden Bus Lines, Painter Bus Lines, Transportes Del Rorte Bus Lines, Autobuses Blancos Flecha Roja, and Autobuses Anahuac S. A., are attached.

In addition, Mr. Rankin requested maps of Dallas and Texas, showing hitchhiking routes from Oak Cliff to nearby points on the Mexican border, and locating the bus terminal in Dallas from which buses departed for Mexico.

The hitchhiking route from Dallas to the Maxican border is sketched on Map 1(b) as mentioned above. Map 4(a) which is attached, indicates bus terminals in Dallas, Texas, from which buses would depart for Maxico City. This map also indicates routes taken by Greyhound Bus Lines and Continental Trailways Bus Lines through the city to the highways leading to border areas. Trailways Bus Lines route is sketched in yellow and Greyhound Bus Lines route is sketched in blue. This map also indicates a hitchhiking route to the border. This route is sketched in brown.

Map 4(b) is an inset map of the downtown area of Dallas, showing the location of the Continental Trailways Bus Terminal and the Greyhound Bus Terminal.

NOTE: During the period in question, all buses traveling to the Mexican Border would stop between terminals to pick up passengers, both in cities and on the open highway. This stop would be contingent on traffic regulations and safety procedures. The passengers could then purchase their ticket on the bus.

## SYNOPSIS

Information requested by Mr. David Belin, President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy.

## DETAILS OF INVESTIGATION

Reference is made to a phone call received by SAIC Sorrels from Mr. David Belin, attached to the President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy, in which Mr. Belin requested information relative to bus routes and taxi routes in the Jefferson - Marsalis area.

## Other Investigations

On June 13, 1964, Mr. Belin contacted SAIC Sorrels, telephonically, and asked him the following questions and requested the information be supplied to him in Washington before noon on June 15, 1964. The requested information was gathered and was relayed to Mr. Belin via telephone at approximately 11 P.M. Washington, D. C. time. The questions and answers are as follows:

1. Is there a cab stand in the vicinity of either Marsalis and Jefferson or Jefferson and Ewing Streets?

Mrs. Norma Richards, City Transportation Company, was contacted and she states there are no cab stands in that vicinity; that all cab stands of the City of Dallas are at transportation terminals and hotels.

2. Are there any buses routed by the corner of Jefferson and Marsalis Streets that are also routed in the vicinity of any airports in the southern part of Dallas?

and Skyline Airport. There are no city buses routed in the vicinity of either Redbird or Skyline Airports. It is possible to ride a Greyhound Bus to the vicinity of Skyline Airport which is located adjacent to Highway 77 South, and an individual would be able to stop the Greyhound Bus to be let out at the Skyline Airport. The Central Texas Bus Lines can be boarded at either the Continental Trailways or Greyhound Bus Stations, or flagged at intersections along the route; travels to Duncanville, Texas, and is routed past the Redbird Airport. It is possible for an individual to request the bus be stopped in the vicinity of Redbird Airport, and thereby to have access to the airport.

3. A transfer ticket was found on the person of Lee Harvey Oswald at the time of his arrest. This transfer ticket was torn at 1 P.M. How long would the transfer be valid, and where could the transfer be used?

The transfer normally given by the bus line is valid for 15 minutes. If the buses to which the transfer is being made are scheduled an hour apart, the transfer would be good for the next bus, regardless of the length of time from leaving the bus from which the transfer ticket was obtained. The transfer would be valid anywhere along the route of the bus from which the ticket was received, and could be used at any routed bus crossing that particular bus line, i.e., if an individual rode on bus route A and obtained a transfer therefrom, the individual could conceivably transfer to bus line B at any point along the route of bus line A, provided the transfer be used within 15 minutes of the time of issue, or upon the next scheduled bus after the time of issue.

4. Can the Greyhound, Continental or City Bus Lines be flagged anywhere along the route?

The City Bus Lines have designated bus stops and can only be boarded at these bus stops. The Continental and Greyhound Bus Lines can be flagged by persons anywhere along the route; these lines will stop and pick these persons up. The ticket is then purchased on the bus for cash.

5. What is the route of the Greyhound Bus Line stopping at the Lisbon flag stop?

The Lisbon flag stop is a designation for a stop by Greyhound Buses at the Veterans Administration Hospital, which is located on Lancaster Road. The bus travels from the downtown area across the Corinth Street Viaduct to Corinth Street; down Corinth Street to Lancaster; and then down Lancaster to the Veterans Administration Hospital. The bus then continues on Spur 342, which intersects with Highway 77 going south midway between Dallas, Texas, and Waxahachie, Texas. There is no specific bus stop at the Veterans Administration Hospital, although the Veterans Administration

Hospital has an entrance directly across Lancaster from the corner of Mentor Avenue and Lancaster, and it is presumed the bus would be flagged from that place.

6. What is the location of the Pleasant Run flag stop on the Greyhound Bus route to Waco?

The Pleasant Run flag stop is a crossroads intersecting Highway 77 in the approximate area of suburban communities of Deloto and Wilmer.

7. What bus routes can be boarded at the intersection of Marsalis and Jefferson?

The Marsalis bus route, which travels from the downtown Dallas area to the Singing Hills residential area in Oak Cliff, Dullas; the Sumset Hampton bus route, which travels south on Jefferson to Hampton Road, then returns to Dallas as the Lagow and Second bus travels north on Jefferson to the downtown area.

Bus route No. 55, Lancaster bus, begins at Kingsley Avenue and travels north on Lancaster making a stop at the Veterans Administration Hospital. Prior to February 12, 1962, this bus did make a turn-around in the Jefferson-Marsalis area, however, this turn-around was eliminated, and the bus now travels directly into the downtown area. A schedule is attached. Also attached is a schedule of bus line route No. 30, Marsalis, which indicates the route as traveling from Pentagon to the downtown area on Marsalis via the Houston Street Viaduct. Also, on the same schedule card, is route No. 15, Ramona, showing the route as starting near Kingsley, proceeding north on Ramona and Ewing Streets, intersecting at Marsalis on Opera Street, and continuing north via the Houston Street Viaduct to the downtown area.

8. Does the Greyhound Bus that makes the Lisbon flag stop pick up passengers at any other places?

The Greyhound Bus line will pick up any passengers upon being flagged anywhere along their route provided it is safe to stop on the highways or streets.

9. What is the general description of the area near the Veterans Administration Hospital, with specific reference to restaurants or theaters?

The Veterans Administration Hospital has a circular driveway. The southern entrance begins at 4700 Lancaster; the northern entrance at 4400 Lancaster. The following places of business are in the Veterans Administration Hospital area, all on Lancaster Road:

Arthur's Restaurant - Corner Mentor and Lancaster - 4400 Block Lancaster South Cliff Cafe and Motel - near corner of Mentor and Lancaster - 4500 Block Lancaster

Next to the South Cliff Cafe and Motel, there are two private homes with bedrooms for rent - also in the 4500 Block Lancaster

A washateria across from the southern entrance to the Veterans Administration Hospital - 4700 Block Lancaster

A cafe in the 4900 Block Lancaster

(There are no business places such as cafes or movie houses on the corner of Ledbetter and Lancaster.)

The South Oak Cliff Library is located in the 3000 Block of Lancaster. The South Oak Cliff Shopping Center is located between the 3000 and 3300 Blocks of Lancaster.

The Crest Theater is located in the 2600 Block Lancaster.





It is presumed that in the telephone conversation between Mr. David Belin and Special Agent Warner as referenced in SA Warner's M/R of 6-15-64 relative to various bus routes in the Cak Cliff area, that Mr. Belin was referring to a Dallas Transit Company route map.

Although the map is newly printed, it is out of date in re exact routing of buses. The map shows bus route No. 55 making a scheduled turnaround in the Ewing - Jefferson Streets area of Oak Cliff. This map is erroneous in that the bus on that route has not made that turn since February 1962.

A map is attached for your information. The questioned area is outlined in blue pencil.

## SYNOPSIS

Information requested by Mr. David Belin, President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy.

## DETAILS OF INVESTIGATION

Reference is made to a phone call received by SAIC Sorrels from Mr. David Belin, attached to the President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy, in which Mr. Belin requested information relative to bus routes and taxi routes in the Jefferson - Marsalis area.

## Other Investigations

On June 13, 1964, Mr. Belin contacted SAIC Sorrels, telephonically, and asked him the following questions and requested the information be supplied to him in Washington before noon on June 15, 1964. The requested information was gathered and was relayed to Mr. Belin via telephone at approximately 11 P.M. Washington, D. C. time. The questions and answers are as follows:

1. Is there a cab stand in the vicinity of either Marsalis and Jefferson or Jefferson and Ewing Streets?

Mrs. Norma Richards, City Transportation Company, was contacted and she states there are no cab stands in that vicinity; that all cab stands of the City of Dallas are at transportation terminals and hotels.

2. Are there any buses routed by the corner of Jefferson and Marsalis Streets that are also routed in the vicinity of any airports in the southern part of Dallas?

and Skyline Airport. There are no city buses routed in the vicinity of either Redbird or Skyline Airports. It is possible to ride a Greyhound Bus to the vicinity of Skyline Airport which is located adjacent to Highway 77 South, and an individual would be able to stop the Greyhound Bus to be let out at the Skyline Airport. The Central Texas Bus Lines can be boarded at either the Continental Trailways or Greyhound Bus Stations, or flagged at intersections along the route; travels to Duncanville, Texas, and is routed past the Redbird Airport. It is possible for an individual to request the bus be stopped in the vicinity of Redbird Airport, and thereby to have access to the airport.

3. A transfer ticket was found on the person of Lee Harvey Oswald at the time of his arrest. This transfer ticket was torn at 1 P.M. How long would the transfer be valid, and where could the transfer be used?

The transfer normally given by the bus line is valid for 15 minutes. If the buses to which the transfer is being made are scheduled an hour apart, the transfer would be good for the next bus, regardless of the length of time from leaving the bus from which the transfer ticket was obtained. The transfer would be valid anywhere along the route of the bus from which the ticket was received, and could be used at any routed bus crossing that particular bus line, i.e., if an individual rode on bus route A and obtained a transfer therefrom, the individual could conceivably transfer to bus line B at any point along the route of bus line A, provided the transfer be used within 15 minutes of the time of issue, or upon the next scheduled bus after the time of issue.

4. Can the Greyhound, Continental or City Bus Lines be flagged anywhere along the route?

The City Bus Lines have designated bus stops and can only be boarded at these bus stops. The Continental and Greyhound Bus Lines can be flagged by persons anywhere along the route; these lines will stop and pick these persons up. The ticket is then purchased on the bus for cash.

5. What is the route of the Greyhound Bus Line stopping at the Lisbon flag stop?

The Lisbon flag stop is a designation for a stop by Greyhound Buses at the Veterans Administration Hospital, which is located on Lancaster Road. The bus travels from the downtown area across the Corinth Street Viaduct to Corinth Street; down Corinth Street to Lancaster; and then down Lancaster to the Veterans Administration Hospital. The bus then continues on Spur 342, which intersects with Highway 77 going south midway between Dallas, Texas, and Waxahachie, Texas. There is no specific bus stop at the Veterans Administration Hospital, although the Veterans Administration

Hospital has an entrance directly across Lancaster from the corner of Mentor Avenue and Lancaster, and it is presumed the bus would be flagged from that place.

6. What is the location of the Pleasant Run flag stop on the Greyhound Bus

The Pleasant Run flag stop is a crossroads intersecting Highway 77 in the approximate area of suburban communities of DeSoto and Wilmer.

7. What bus routes can be boarded at the intersection of Marsalis and Jefferson?

The Marsalis bus route, which travels from the downtown Dallas area to the Singing Hills residential area in Cak Cliff, Dallas; the Sunset Hampton bus route, which travels south on Jefferson to Hampton Road, then returns to Dallas as the Lagow and Second bus travels north on Jefferson to the downtown area.

Bus route No. 55, Lancaster bus, begins at Kingsley Avenue and travels north on Lancaster making a stop at the Veterans Administration Hospital. Prior to February 12, 1962, this bus did make a turn-around in the Jefferson-Marsalis area, however, this turn-around was eliminated, and the bus now travels directly into the downtown area. A schedule is attached. Also attached is a schedule of bus line route No. 30, Marsalis, which indicates the route as traveling from Pentagon to the downtown area on Marsalis via the Houston Street Viaduct. Also, on the same schedule card, is route No. 15, Ramona, showing the route as starting near Kingsley, proceeding north on Ramona and Ewing Streets, intersecting at Marsalis on Opera Street, and continuing north via the Houston Street Viaduct to the downtown area.

8. Does the Greyhound Bus that makes the Lisbon flag stop pick up passengers at any other places?

The Greyhound Bus line will pick up any passengers upon being flagged anywhere along their route provided it is safe to stop on the highways or streets.

9. What is the general description of the area near the Veterans Administration Hospital, with specific reference to restaurants or theaters?

The Veterans Administration Hospital has a circular driveway. The southern entrance begins at 4700 Lancaster; the northern entrance at 4400 Lancaster. The following places of business are in the Veterans Administration Hospital area, all on Lancaster Road:

Arthur's Restaurant - Corner Mentor and Lancaster - 4400 Block Lancaster South Cliff Cafe and Motel - near corner of Mentor and Lancaster - 4500 Block Lancaster

Next to the South Cliff Cafe and Motel, there are two private homes with bedrooms for rent - also in the 4500 Block Lancaster

A washateria across from the southern entrance to the Veterans Administration Hospital - 4700 Block Lancaster

A cafe in the 4900 Block Lancaster

(There are no business places such as cafes or movie houses on the corner of Ledbetter and Lancaster.)

The South Oak Cliff Library is located in the 3000 Block of Lancaster. The South Oak Cliff Shopping Center is located between the 3000 and 3300 Blocks of Lancaster.

The Crest Theater is located in the 2600 Block Lancaster.



It is presumed that in the telephone conversation between Mr. David Belin and Special Agent Warner as referenced in SA Warner's M/R of 6-15-64 relative to various bus routes in the Oak Cliff area, that Mr. Belin was referring to a Dallas Transit Company route map.

Although the map is newly printed, it is out of date in re exact routing of buses. The map shows bus route No. 55 making a scheduled turnaround in the Ewing - Jefferson Streets area of Oak Cliff. This map is erroneous in that the bus on that route has not made that turn since February 1962.

A map is attached for your information. The questioned area is outlined in blue pencil.
