On Saturday, June 5, 1976, Susan Ford will be an honored guest at the 35th Annual Milk Day Celebration in Harvard, Illinois. The celebration is sponsored by the city of Harvard to honor dairy farmers for their outstanding contribution to this country's rural heritage. Susan's great grandfather, Mr. L. A. Gardner, was Mayor of Harvard in 1895 and 1896.

The celebration includes a parade, dairy shows, horse shows, dairy farm tours, milking contests, milk drinking contests, square dancing, and other activities representing rural America.

Harvard, a city of about 5,000 people, is known as "The Milk Capital of the World."
