Attached is a set of materials prepared for the transition to your second Administration.

The first paper, entitled "Planning the Transition" identifies items you may wish to consider in order to ensure maximum (lexibility in sharing the policies, structure and people of your new Administration. It is basically a paper designed to prevent events from setting out of control during the transition period. A second paper entitled "Presidential Chiectives" sketches out a series of chiectives around which you might wish to organize your second Administration. The themes of peace. prosperity and trust are identified as the key elements and specific nolicy and programmatic suggestions are identified under each of these three themes. If you choose to pursue these objectives, some brief organizing principles are identified. The third paper entitled "Modern Mid-term Transitions: The Implications for President Ford" was averaged by the Institute of Dollties at the Kennedy School of Companyent under the direction of Jonathan Moore. That paper examines in some detail mid-term transitions from Vincehouses to Nisco. It concludes that most mid-term transitions have not been successful because the re-elected President lost his chance for sharing events in the direction he wished. The first 11 pages of the study, which summarize previous transitions, may he of interest to you.
